

# Construction Activities Update: May 19 – May 30, 2025 PLEASE BE ALERT!

## Traffic control is in place for your safety!

Recommended speed through roundabouts (during construction) is 15 MPH
The enforceable speed limit through the construction zone is 25 MPH

- Abrams Drive (north) and Imjin Road are closed at Imjin Parkway until 5/29
- Imjin Pkwy to Reservation Road one right turn is closed

# What's Happening in the Next 2 Weeks (May 19 – May 30) Day Shift

- Continue grading of base rock for south side Imjin Parkway roadway section between Marina Heights Drive and Shell station driveway.
- Continue earthwork/grading and base rock for south side Imjin Parkway roadway section from Preston Drive ½ roundabout to Reservation Road.
- Complete electrical conduits, irrigation service lines, bio swales, drainage, sidewalk, and curb & gutter at Abrams Drive (north).
- Install revised striping and transition traffic between Preston Drive and Abrams Drive (north) to transition traffic to north roadbed (scheduled for the night of 5/29). This will coincide with reopening Abrams Drive (north) to right-in/right-out traffic movements.
- Install revised striping and transition traffic near Imjin Road to the south roadbed and re-open Imjin Road to right-in/right-out traffic movements (scheduled for the night of 5/29).
- Pave bike/pedestrian path near Abrams Drive; currently scheduled for 5/16.
- Continue environmental monitoring of contractor activities job wide.

<u>Night Shift</u> – Closure of Imjin Parkway is scheduled for the night of 5/29 to perform work required to shift traffic at:

- Abrams Drive the north side will re-open to right in/right out traffic. Abrams Drive (south) will be closed to all traffic to construct the new roadway and the south ½ of the roundabout.
- ➤ Imjin Road the roadway will re-open to right in/right out traffic and traffic will be shifted from the north side of the roundabout to the newly constructed south side (the side closest to Imjin Road) of the roundabout.

Activities will include moving concrete barriers, striping removal and new striping for revised traffic flows. Hours of work are anticipated to be from 7PM to 6AM. Impacts will be noise from equipment used to relocate concrete barriers, and large equipment used for striping. Portable light plants will be utilized to provide adequate lighting for operations on the roadway; every effort will be made to avoid light impacts for adjacent residences.

This traffic shift will allow us to remove/replace temporary paving that is currently in use (between the retaining wall east of Imjin Road to the western project limits) and to construct the final first layer of asphalt for the roadway section for the north roadbed and in the middle of the roadways from the roundabout going east.



### Activities That Took Place Last Week (May 12 – May 16)

- Continued installing irrigation service lines and digging planting pits on slopes along Imjin Parkway between Imjin Road and Abrams Drive.
- Paved first layer of asphalt at Abrams Drive (north). This completes the first layer of asphalt on the north side from Reservation Road to the area just east of Imjin Road.
- Installed street light and pedestrian beacon foundations, median curb, sidewalk, and curb & gutter on Abrams Drive (north).
- Completed construction of south side ½ roundabout at Marina Heights Drive.
- Paved first layer of asphalt at Imjin Road and the south roadway section of Imjin Parkway between Imjin Road and Marina Heights Drive.

#### Future Construction Activity and Information: What's Planned in the Future?

- Complete all earthwork (cuts & fills) by end of June.
- > Re-open Abrams Drive (south) in August.
